

Shoes

- Shoes should be considered safe and appropriate for various school activities.
- Footwear that is deemed to be a safety hazard will not be permitted.

Shorts

- Shorts may be worn as long as they are not “short” shorts.
- “Short” shorts or biker shorts (Spandex) are not to be worn by students.

Pants

- Pants should be secured at the waist- no sagging below the waist to expose an undergarment is permitted.

Skirts/Dresses

- Skirts, dresses and shorts should be appropriate in length.

Hats

- Hats will not be worn that display or promote chemical substance abuse, alcohol, tobacco, satanic symbols or representations or inappropriate or offensive language.
- Headgear such as bandanas or “doo-rags” are prohibited.

REMINDERS: Students are not permitted to wear any shirt or blouse that exposes any part of their stomach or midriff area. Tube tops, spaghetti straps or any other similar garments are not permitted in the school. This rule will be strictly enforced and students who wear these garments will not be permitted to attend class.

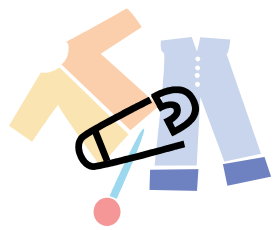

Dress Code:

Students should dress appropriately for school activities, and should be assisted in making choices regarding appropriate dress with the help of their parents.

Articles of clothing and /or accessories that are deemed objectionable in style, wording, etc. by the school staff will be replaced by more suitable clothing. Clothing or accessories that are deemed representative of gangs, high school fraternities/ sororities, etc. cannot be worn. Parents will be contacted in this



situation to assist in resolving the problem.

Parents will be notified and asked to bring appropriate clothing if their child/children are in violation of any of the following guidelines:

No see-through clothing is permitted.

Clothing should be appropriate in length.

Clothing and accessories such as backpacks, patches, jewelry, and notebooks must not display (1) racial or ethnic slurs/symbols, (2) gang affiliations, (3) vulgar, subversive, or sexually suggestive language or images; nor, should they promote products which students may not legally buy, such as alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs.



T-shirts, patches, belt buckles, necklaces, and other wearing apparel that displays suggestive words, pictures, or advertisements are prohibited.

Items that are vulgar, obscene, libelous or denigrate others on account of race, color, religion, creed, national origin, gender, sexual orientation or dis-

abilities are prohibited.

Shirts

All clothing should be appropriate for a school environment.



Clothing which is disruptive to the educational setting is prohibited.

- Shirts will not be worn that display or promote chemical substance abuse, alcohol, tobacco or satanic symbols or representations, or inappropriate or offensive language.
- No muscle shirts. Muscle shirts are defined as shirts with large armholes and neck holes. Youngsters should consider a “muscle shirt” as gym attire only.
- All shirts and blouses must be appropriate in length. Extremely brief garments and garments that are see-through are prohibited.
